Children may be eligible for Expanded funding from the term after they turn 9 months of age. Children will move to 2-year-old funding and fees the term after they turn 2 and move to 3 & 4 year old funding and fees the term after they turn 3.

Funding is applied to afternoon sessions 4.47 hours per day, 51 weeks of the year. This equates to 2.5 afternoons per week if eligible for Expanded (the term after a child turns 9 months to 2 year olds) or Universal funding, 5 afternoons a week if eligible for both Universal & Extended funding (from the term after a child turns 3 years of age only). Funded only sessions are only offered in the afternoons, in line with our fee structuring and are subject to availability.

10% discount for 2 or more children will be applied to the oldest child, to the 'parent to pay' portion of the fees.
