## Covid-19 and changes to symptomatic testing

This morning we have received a brief update on the changes to current CV-19 testing and isolation procedures from the Department for Education (DfE), which will come into effect tomorrow.

The update states, that from Friday April 1<sup>st</sup> 'children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend'.

Once we receive more information or guidance we will let you know, but from tomorrow this is the approach that will be followed at nursery, in line with the update from the DfE.

Once we have received all the information (we expect more will be forthcoming when documents are updated) we will also begin to look at our current measures that are in place. We are very hopeful that we may be able to look at having an outdoor event take place this summer, such as a celebratory BBQ or similar activity. We have missed not being able to offer the events that we did Pre-Covid 19 and are hopeful that somethings may return this year!

### Ofsted

We would like to thank you for all your kind congratulatory messages after our recent Ofsted inspection announcement; we shared your lovely messages with the staff team at our most recent (virtual) staff meeting. The report can also now be found online or via a link on our website. As we have already said,

we are extremely delighted to again be awarded the rating of 'Outstanding' across all areas of our provision. We are very pleased that the inspection reflects the ongoing progress of nursery to continually develop and grow for all and recognises that our 'children are exceptionally confident and thrive in practitioners nurturing care'. The inspector gave feedback that it was virtually unheard of to be awarded 'Outstanding' for a fourth time and that it was evident that we 'never let the grass grow under our feet'; that everyone is continually reflecting on practice and looking at ways we can improve our provision further.

#### **General Infection Control Guidance**

Babraham Nursery, in line with all childcare settings and schools, follows the guidance set by the UK Health Security Agency (formerly Public Health England) with regards to general infection control. This guidance also states the period a child should be kept away from the setting should they become unwell. Your support in following these procedures is greatly appreciated, as this minimises the risk of spreading general infections in nursery to other children in nursery and to our staff team.
