#### Dear Parents,

Welcome to the summer edition of our Nursery Newsletter, we hope that this email finds you all well. We would also like to welcome our new families who have joined us at nursery since our last newsletter.

It has been wonderful to be able to begin welcoming some of the children back to nursery and we all hope that we can continue with our phased return. Like schools and other settings, we look forward to receiving further information from the Department for Education of when we will be allowed to fully reopen. We are very much looking forward to getting back to usual at nursery when we can.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support over the past few months and whilst we are in our phased return. We realise this is an unusual time and nursery is slightly different whilst we are operating under our restrictions. Every day we are adapting what we do as we receive new information and we thank you for your continued patience. Please remember that **our current session times are 8.45-12.45 and 1.45-5.45/5.15** (Fridays), it is very important that you leave enough time to collect your child as the break between sessions enables thorough cleaning and the staff to have their breaks. We apologise for the need to queue and the more lengthy drop-offs and collections, this is currently unavoidable with the necessary social distancing measures. We therefore suggest, that you arrive at least 10 minutes before the end of the session to collect your child whilst these sessions are in place.

#### **Training day**

As discussed in previous newsletters, displayed on the notice board and in our terms and conditions; **Babraham Nursery will be closed on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2020** (as the first Friday in July) **for staff training**. This is the one opportunity throughout the year when the whole staff team is able to get together (socially-distanced) for training purposes. Please note, no fees will be charged for this day.

# **Nursery Barbeque**



This year our annual nursery BBQ was due to go ahead on Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> September, this has sadly been cancelled for safety reasons. This is particularly unfortunate as Nursery is celebrating its 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary this year. Children from essential working families who have continued to attend Nursery will receive their reports in June as usual.

All new children to nursery and children who resume their attendance in July onwards will receive their report in October. If you would like an update once your child has settled back into nursery I am sure that you child's key worker will be happy to share their observations with you.

# Funding for 3 and 4 year olds

May I please take this opportunity to remind families who are in receipt of the extended entitlement for early years funding, that their code from HMRC must be validated every three months in order for the funding to continue. Unfortunately, if a code is not revalidated by the parent with HMRC within the timeframe set by HMRC, the HMRC will withdraw the funding. Unfortunately this system is beyond our control.

If your child turns three this term (before 31.8.20) and you think you may be eligible for the extended entitlement, please ensure you are in receipt of an eligibility code from the HMRC, in preparation for September.
